“The Usual Suspects: Homosexuality, Ordaining Gay Clergy, and Blessing Same-sex Unions”

Issues of homosexuality have been much in the news of late. The Supreme Court is considering two major cases involving gay marriage. Our own church has authorized a provisional liturgy for the blessing of same-sex unions, and it regularly ordains gays and lesbians. In our diocese, Bishop McConnell has initiated a diocesan-wide dialogue intended to inform his decisions on allowing same-sex blessings and on ordaining partnered homosexuals. The Rev. Dr. McIntyre will discuss issues of homosexuality from a progressive Episcopal perspective. Attendees may wish to read a background paper by the Rev.
