

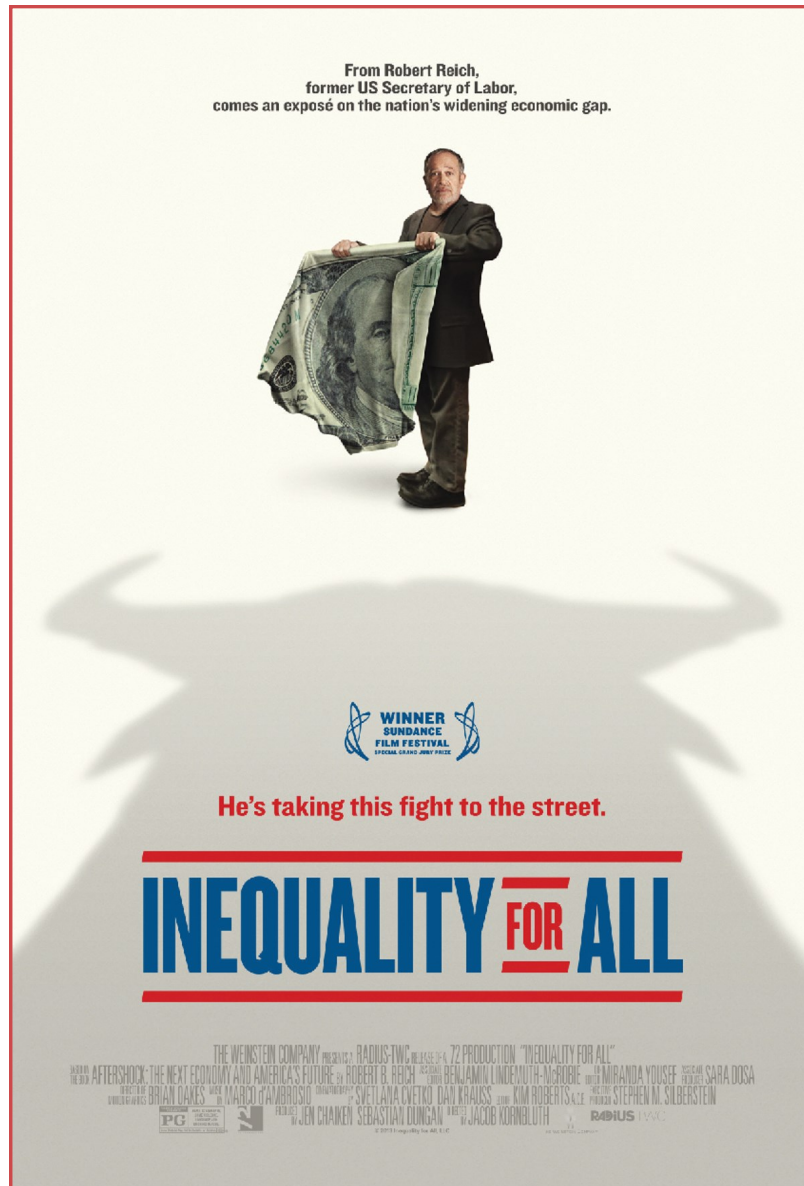

In 1970, the top 1% of earners took home 9% of the nation's income. Today they take in approximately 23%. The top 1% holds more than 35% of the nation's overall wealth, while the bottom 50% controls a meager 2.5%.
