### Reflections on the Path from B033 to D025 and Beyond

The last three General Conventions of The Episcopal Church have forever changed the relationship of our church to the Anglican Communion. In 2003, GC consented to the consecration of Gene Robinson as Bishop of New Hampshire. In response to the Windsor Report, the 2006 GC passed B033, which called for restraint in consenting to the consecration of persons “whose manner of life presents a challenge to the wider church.” Resolution D025, passed by the 2009 GC, renewed the church’s commitment both to the Anglican Communion and to gays and lesbians in the church. **Where We Are** presents an opportunity to hear from someone who was at the center of the action in Anaheim and to discuss the future of The Episcopal Church and the Anglican Communion.
